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INTRODUCTION

This volume seeks to present a composite register of Births, Deaths and Monumental Inscriptions of past generations associated with the Horsham Baptist Meeting House as disclosed by their records which have come down to us. It is hoped it will prove of some help to students of this and future generations who may be studying the history of the religious movement which gave rise to the meeting house and to those who may be studying the genealogy of their families, some of whose names may appear in these records.

To those who may use this book a word of caution is necessary. Though the records have been transcribed with reasonable care, some errors are likely to remain. Thus the serious student would be wise to consult the originals, albeit using this register and its index as a guide.

More can be learnt of a number of people whose names appear in this book by consultation of other sources, particularly Wills and Marriage Licences etc to be found in various Record Offices. The compiler has been much indebted to the researches of others in that area. But no attempt has been made to incorporate any such additional information here other than in the index where the year of birth or death might not have been otherwise known. This has been done only as an aid to identify people, particularly those with identical names.

BIRTHS REGISTER

The original register covers the period 1724 to 1837 but with some earlier retrospective entries. It is now to be found amongst the Non-Parochial Registers in the Public Record Office under reference RG4 2729. The origin of the register is explained on the first page of the folio volume and is reproduced as the frontispiece of the present work. It reads:

Agreed at a Church Meeting of Baptists held at Horsham in Sussex July 1:1724 That forasmuch as the Ministers of the Church of England refuse to Register our Children, it was thought convenient & necessary for us to do it amongst our Selves; and accordingly it was concluded that John Tasker have the Charge of the same; and that he receive, and enter Regularly into this Book all

such Births as shall be requested, and desired, of any Friends belonging to our Society And that public Notice be given hereof, that so, any Persons who have not for Time past, may henceforward have the Oppertunity to have Registered as well those which have been Born some Time past (upon certain Evidence) as those wch shall hereafter be Born. And further we think it necessary; that the Person Deputed to Register and keep the Book have Reasonable Encouragement for the Orderly doing the same.

In making the transcription all the significant information has been included but the format has been simplified and serial numbers added for ease of reference.

In her History of the Free Christian Church Horsham of 1921 Emily Kensett gives a delightful description of the register to which the interested reader is recommended to refer.

DEATHS/BURIALS REGISTER

The original registration of deaths or burials had a less formal beginning than did the births. The meeting house was erected in 1721 upon ground acquired in 1719. Stephen Rowland (1710-1789) appears to have been responsible for grave digging for some considerable time and to have received payment for the same. He kept a record in a curious book in which he entered details of payments received and other odd items of information. The earliest entry is to be found in the middle of the book suggesting that the book itself was a rebinding including some older sheets. The first page of the book bears the inscription 'Step. Rowland - December 12 1748 - his book' whilst the earliest entry

in the middle of the book reads ' The account of the pepell that are beared febury the 3 there Sarah Messur was buried 1722 '.

The last entry in the book is in 1769 by which time Stephen was perhaps becoming a little old for grave digging. The book is also in the Public Record Office under reference RG4 2062 as is also a description of it given in Emily Kensett's History.

A second register was begun in 1771 and kept in the same folio volume as the births. It carried on till 1837 when it was sent off to the General Registration Office under the provisions of the Act 3 & 4 Vict cap 92 which set up the General Registration of Births, Marriages and Deaths.

No subsequent register of deaths or burials kept by the meeting house has been traced by the compiler.

MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS

Under this heading are given the inscriptions on all the tombstones where known or the names of the grave occupants where no stone appears to have been erected. Also included are the graves mentioned in one or other of the original sources but the precise location of which can not now be established.

At some time round about 1900, Arnold Ridley Bax FSA made careful notes of the inscriptions of most of the then existing tombstones in the burial grounds. These notes were entered into a bound volume which was eventually deposited in the Library of the Sussex Archaeological Society of which he was a member from 1891 till his death at the age of 74 in 1918. Ridley Bax was a Barrister of Middle Temple but evidently devoted much of his time to antiquarian pursuits, particularly the recording of tombstone inscriptions. Whether he was related in any way to the family of Bax whose name appears in this register is not recorded.

The work of Ridley Bax has been invaluable. It is the main source of the detailed inscriptions here given and which are taken verbatim from his notes.

The second source has been the Index to the Plan of the Burial Ground prepared by Gordon N Slyfield in 1955. A copy of this was deposited in the Sussex Archaeological Society Library from which the necessary information was taken.

Gordon Slyfield was a man of many interests. He was a surveyor, ornithologist, meteorologist and archaeologist. He lived and worked in Horsham and at the time of his death in 1965 at the age of 52 he was best known for his articles on local weather in the West Sussex County Times. He was descended from the ancient family of Slyfield Manor, Great Bookham but whether any of his other ancestors were buried in the grounds of the meeting house is not clear.

The Slyfield Index with its own numbering system came to light late in the researches of the compiler and after he had committed himself to a numbering system based upon the Ridley Bax records. But for this the much clearer system of Slyfield would have been adopted. Cross-reference tables have thus had to be resorted to.

The post 1955 Monumental Inscriptions have been kindly provided by Thomas Holt, one of the present Trustees.

A considerable number of tombstones at the front of the meeting house were removed some years ago. More recently virtually the whole of the stones in the south burial ground were removed and either used as paving stones or piled behind the meeting house.

The antiquarian will naturally regret the removal of the stones. The custom of burial around ones church or chapel is fast vanishing. Future generations will treasure such churchyards as do survive intact. But small congregations with limited finances are ill able to maintain their grounds when cluttered with stones, and unkempt grounds invite vandalism. The antiquarian should thus be hesitant to condemn this kind of desecration of churchyards. Rather he should urge that what can be preserved should so be, and what cannot should be recorded carefully and photographed and the results placed in the local Record Office.

PLANS OF THE BURIAL GROUNDS

The Slyfield Plan covers the whole of the burial grounds and identifies each grave known to exist in 1955. The plan has clearly been prepared with considerable care. It is drawn on a single sheet but for ease of printing it has been copied and reproduced in sections by the compiler.

The second plan, the 1908 Plan, so called for the sake of brevity, covers only the south burial ground. It appears to have been quite old when Frank Ireland revised it in 1908. It bears the imprint of many hands and may well go back almost to 1816 when that piece of ground was acquired under a 1000 year lease at a peppercorn rent. The plan now hangs inside the meeting house.

THE GENERAL BAPTISTS

For those unfamiliar with the history of the Baptist movement or for those who may now wonder why some of their ancestors should have adhered to such a movement to the peril of themselves and their families, this brief outline of the story of the movement is offered.

Once Christianity was adopted as the official religion of Rome the politics of church and state became inseparable. Matters of dispute within the church were determined largely by the civil power to suit the pressures of the times. Theological speculation combined with political expediency led to the enforcement of complex creeds barely understandable by the majority and to practices little removed from superstition. The story of increasing corruption and the inevitable reformation has often been told. It is not our real concern here other than to say that it left the church, both reformed and counter-reformed, as bodies still with a large measure of central control and allied directly or indirectly with the civil power.

From the earliest days of Christianity there have been those who considered the true church to be the gathering together of a group of believers endeavouring to live their lives in accordance with the teaching of Jesus. There was no place for a central organisation in their scheme of things nor any authority, other than the word of the

scriptures, to determine points of belief or practice. Such views were anathema to the main stream churches and, as conditions allowed, those holding them were persecuted. These views, already latent in England, began to emerge in the reign of Queen Elizabeth and in sufficient strength to trouble the government. The holders of these views are now known in history as 'Separatists'.

Infant baptism had long been the custom of the traditional church. Initially the separatists accepted the custom without qualms. But those seeking to follow as far as possible the pattern of the primitive churches could find no authority in scripture for the custom. True baptism could only be effected on the believer. Baptism of infants was meaningless. Those already so baptised were re-baptised and dubbed 'Anabaptists' in derision by the public at large though, in time as new generations arose who had not been baptised in infancy, the simpler name of 'Baptist' became more usual and ultimately accepted by themselves. Those retaining the practice of infant baptism took the name 'Independents'.

Both independents and baptists as well as other separatist groups were god-fearing men, rigorously upright, quiet in bearing, separating themselves from the rest of the community both in manners and dress. They were disliked by their neighbours who misunderstood them and by the civil power whose authority in religious matters they denied.

The first formally constituted English Baptist Church appears to have been amongst a group of separatists who had fled to Holland and gathered together a church in Amsterdam in 1609. Three years later under their leader Thomas Helwys they returned to England facing inevitable persecution. The church was dispersed and Helwys died in prison. Not till the civil war do we find the baptists openly flourishing. Cromwell was himself of the independent view. A large proportion of the troops and some officers were baptist. The Horsham community, by tradition, traces its origin from that period.

The restoration of Charles II brought with it a deep reaction against the puritanism of the commonwealth period. Conformity to the reorganised Church of England was enforced by the 1662 Act of Uniformity. Puritan clergy

were ejected from their livings in large numbers. Severe penalties were placed upon anyone found preaching or holding religious services outside the established church. At the same time public and private morals fell to a low ebb, perhaps lower than at any time in our history. It may be said with little exaggeration that the conscience of the country was kept alive by those who had been ejected from, or those who had already separated themselves from, the established church.

Happily such a period of moral degradation could not last and with the Revolution of 1688 and the accession of William and Mary the era of religious toleration commenced. The puritan element represented by the English Presbyterians and the separatists by the Independents, Baptists and others began to build their meeting houses up and down the country. But amongst the baptists the effects of earlier persecution had left its mark. They remained a closed community with extensive intermarriage between their families.

The end of persecution was not without its less desirable effects. With no outside common enemy, internal disputes arose. The earliest baptists followed the Arminian view of salvation being available to all who devoutly sought it and it was from this attitude that they assumed the name of General Baptists. But almost as old was another group who had succeeded from the independents resulting from their abandonment of infant baptism but bringing with them the current Calvinistic view of salvation being available only to those for whom it was preordained i.e. to particular persons only. They assumed the name of Particular Baptists. These differences of view had been no bar to common worship whilst persecution existed. They now became more significant.

The tradition of toleration of differences of view and a reluctance to define points of theology in words other than taken direct from the scriptures was strong within the baptist movement as a whole, but nowhere stronger than in the Kent and Sussex churches which were almost all general baptist. Examination of the ancient creeds disclosed difficulties in reconciling them with the scriptures. Matthew Caffyn, one of the earliest ministers of the Horsham community was singled out for his unorthodox views and the influence he was having on others and the yearly General Baptist Assembly was troubled with attacks by some of his more orthodox colleagues.

Throughout the 18th century the community centred upon Horsham flourished. Honest and hard working people could not but prosper. Nor could the gradual slumbering of the old arguments about dogma and church government fail to tempt some baptist families back to the Church of England with all the advantages that meant. Dissatisfaction with economic conditions and the political situation in the country caused many families to emigrate to America and elsewhere but the gaps were made up by large families at home notwithstanding the dreadful rate of infant mortality which these registers disclose.

Amongst those who remained, the enquiring minds of Matthew Caffyn and his successors steadily eroded the old beliefs, and, almost imperceptibly, the congregation moved towards Unitarianism, as did most of the general baptist churches in Kent and Sussex. By the late 19th century the move was complete. The baptisteries were boarded up and the old name was dropped. But elsewhere in the country the descendants of the more orthodox section who has seceded to form the General Baptist New Connexion maintained the rites of adult baptism and eventually, as the mainstream particular baptists lost their rigid Calvinism, joined them in the present Baptist Union. Only a minority now remain holding tenaciously to the Calvinist system and still practising strict communion. They are the Strict and Particular Baptists. He who ventures to visit one of their Chapels for morning service will perhaps sense something of the spirit of the ancient separatists which no history book can fully impart.

Such a short review has all the defects of over simplification and should be read as such. But it is hoped that it will be sufficient to indicate that the old baptists were, by any standards, an honourable and indeed admirable group of people.

At this point Ridley Bax ceased noting the Monumental Inscriptions in full. Instead he listed all the stones in roughly topographical order giving names and dates only. In doing so a large number of stones were listed for which he had already noted the inscriptions in full

Though this has been helpful in identifying the location of some of the graves, the full transcription of this part of the manuscript did not appear warranted

The remainder of the Monumental Inscriptions which follow are a compilation, partly from the Ridley Bax list, but mainly from Gordon Slyfield's Index to his 1955 Plan of the Burial Grounds

Plans of the Burial Grounds

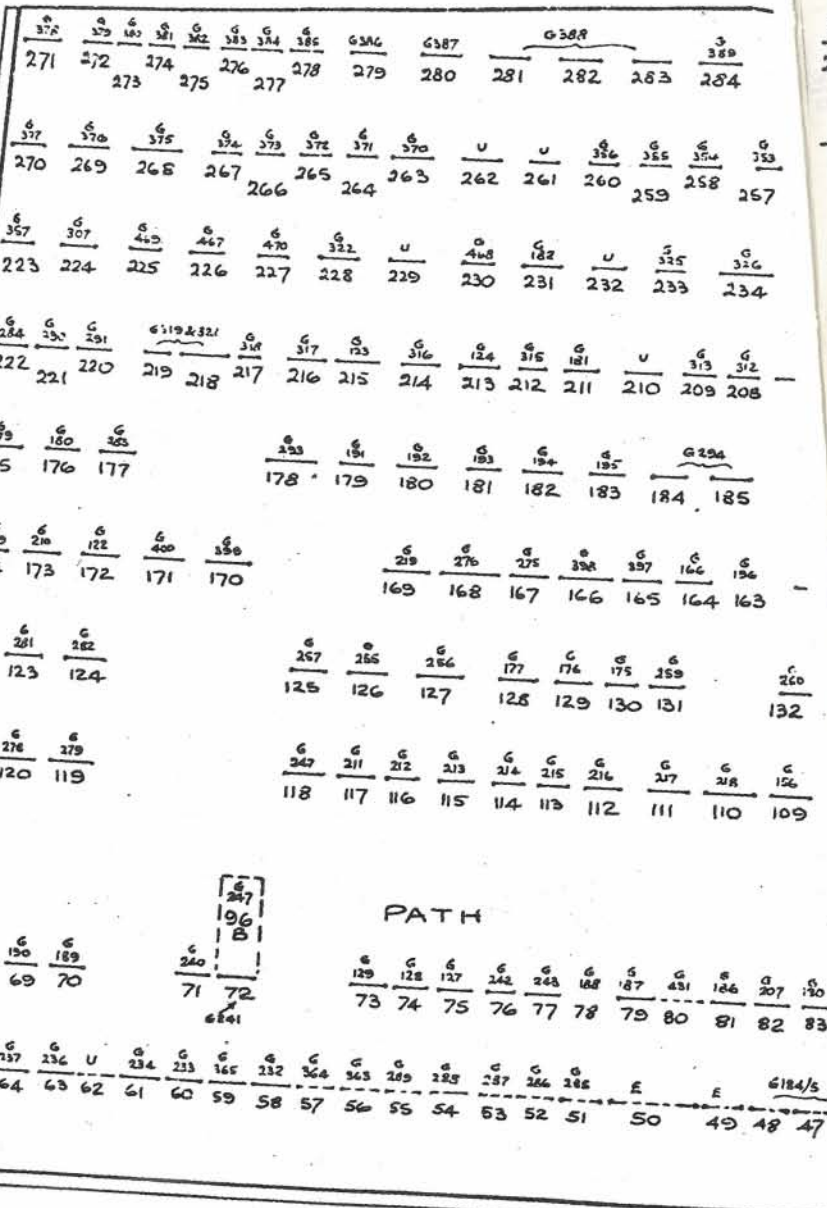
The 1955 Plan of Gordon N Slyfield is reproduced on pages 78 to 83. His system of numbering of the gravestones has been used but, for ease of reference to the Register of Monumental Inscriptions, the latter numbers (prefix 'G') are also given.

The earlier Plan revised in 1908 by Frank Ireland is reproduced on pages 86 & 87. It covers the South Burial Ground only. The two plans conflict here and there so that, for ease of reference, separate numbers have been given for each Plot.

Cross Reference Tables for the Monumental Inscriptions (G), the Slyfield numbering (S), and the 1908 Plot Plan (P) are given on pages 89 et seq.

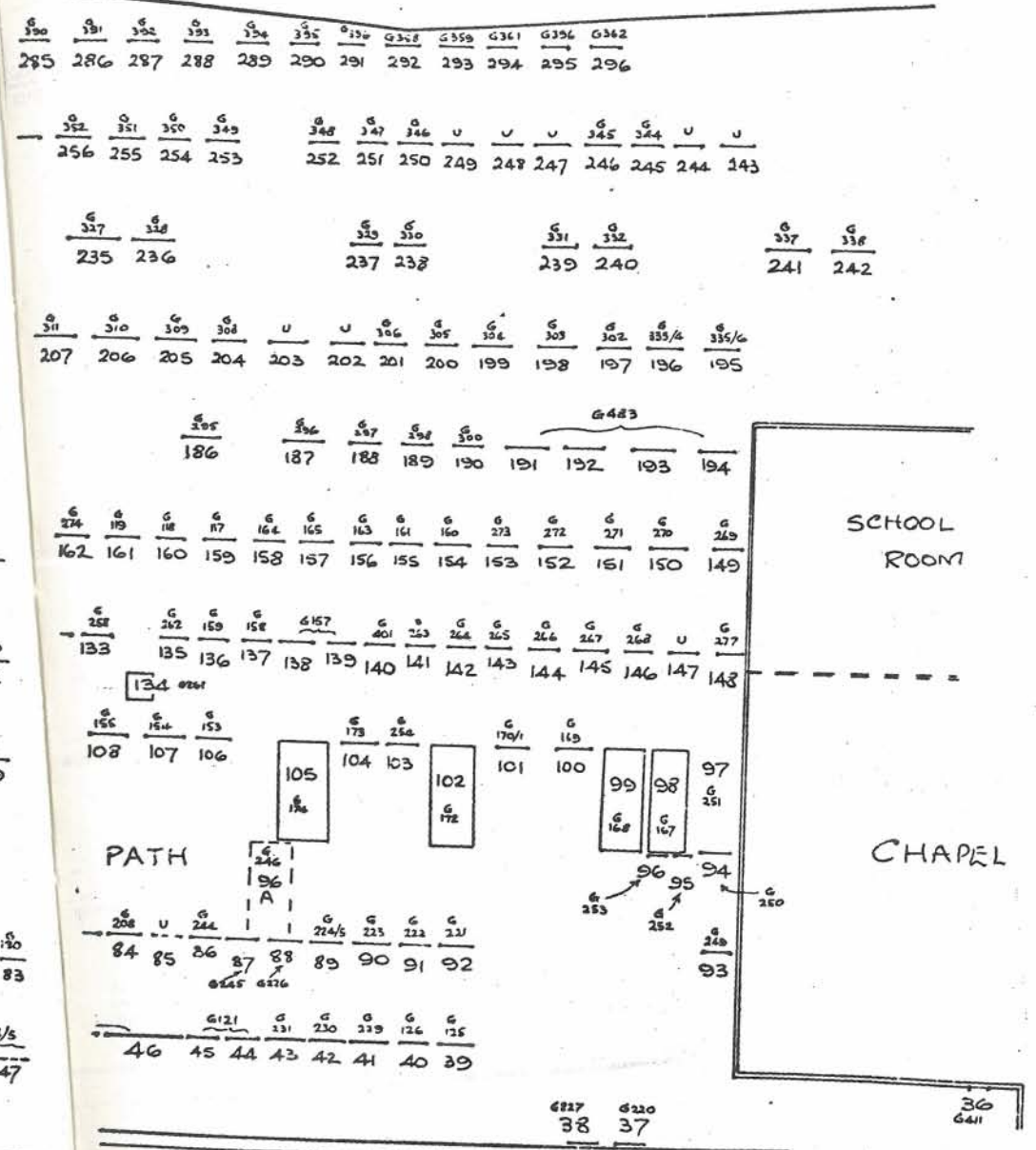

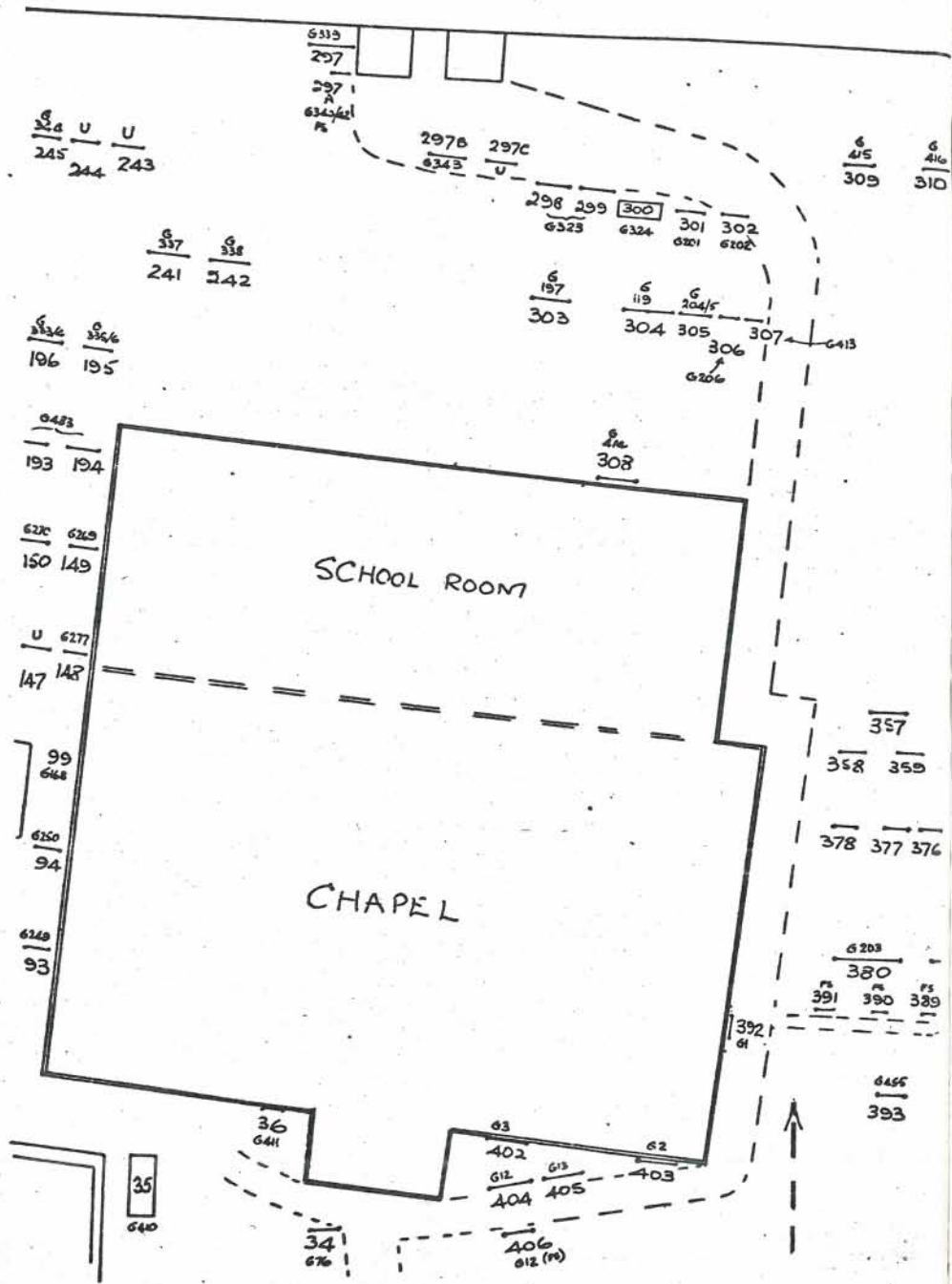

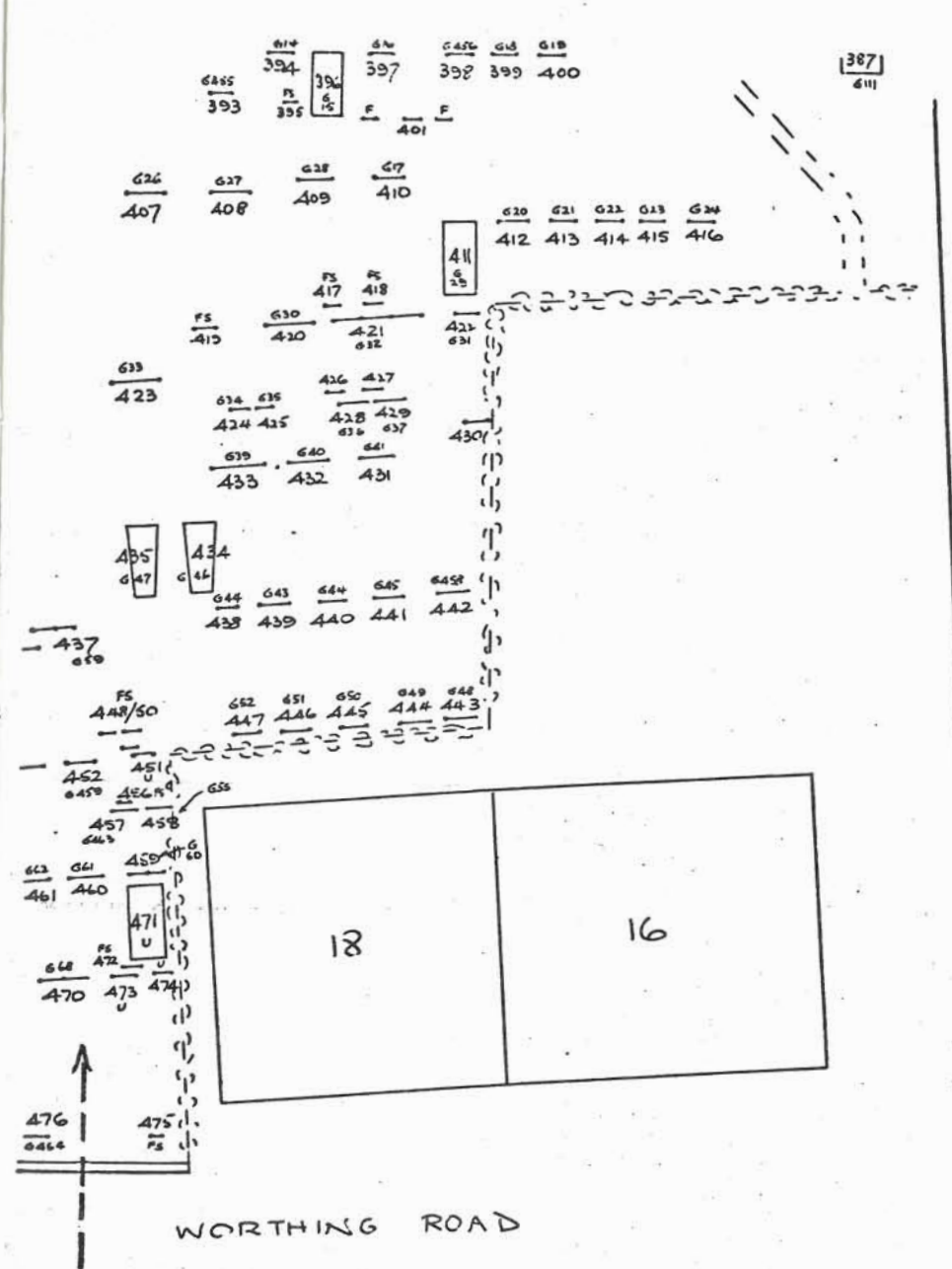
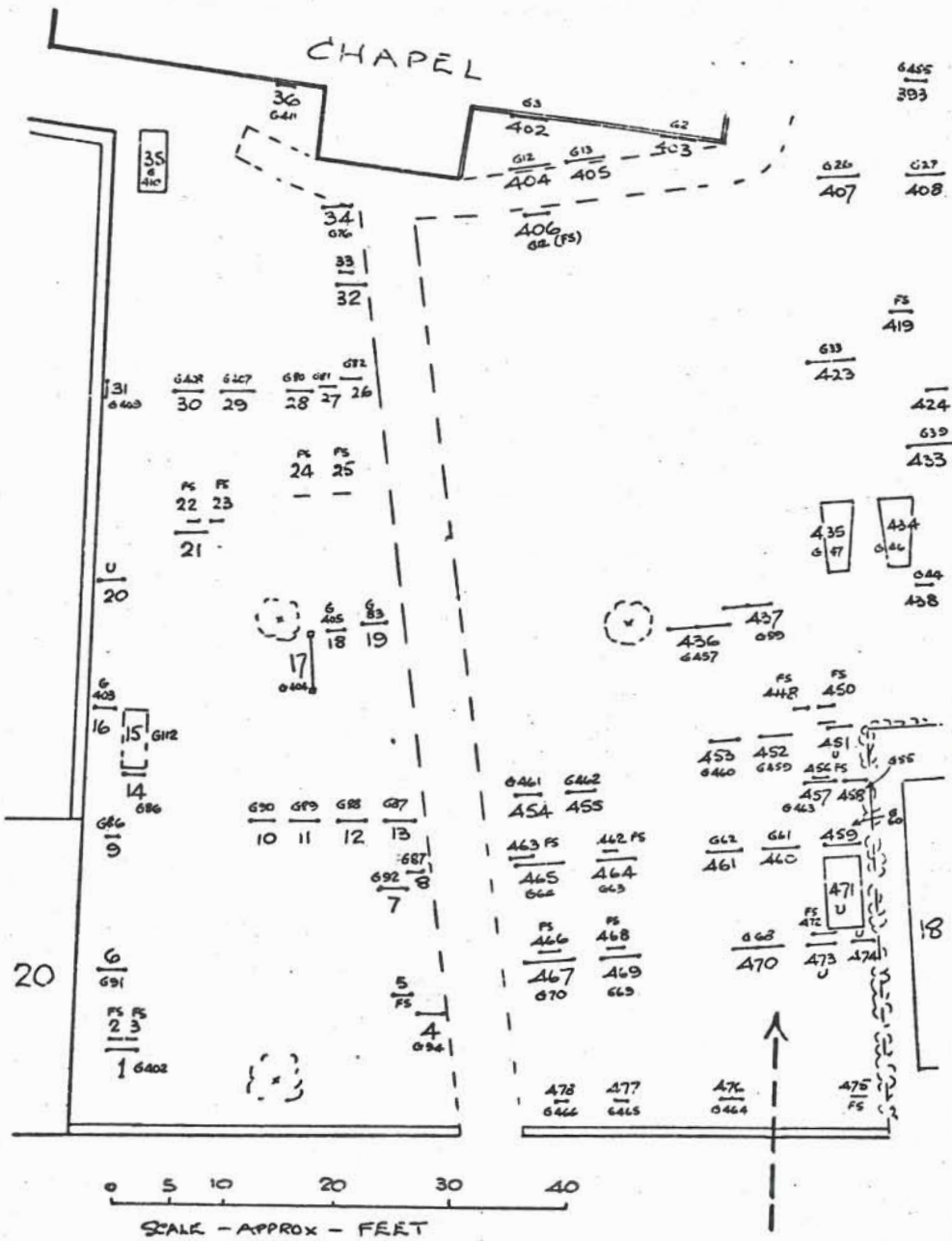
