## INTRODUCTION

There is no doubt that the Monthly Repository, from the time of its first issue on 1 February 1806 until the February 1832 number was the most important and significant journal reflecting Unitarian life and thought of the day. It was founded by the youthful Rev. Robert Aspland (1782-1845) who had only recently become the Minister at the Gravel Pit Unitarian Chapel, Hackney. Open to all comers, in fact it mostly consisted of articles by Unitarians though the contributions were usually anonymous or signed only with pseudonyms. Few of the orthodox accepted the invitation to contribute.

Aspland retained the sole editorship of the Monthly Repository until 1827 though it made him very little money. However, it quickly turned him into a leader of the Unitarian denomination and by the 1820's one of its most significant figures. In 1827 came the Second Series of the magazine. Edited by Rev. W.J. Fox (1786-1864), at first jointly but then solely from August 1828, it gradually became less reflective of Unitarian thinking as its editor moved towards his tumultuous departure from the Unitarian ministry. He bought the Repository outright about October 1831, and altered its future course. Francis E. Mineka showed how this happened in her excellent study "The Dissidence of Dissent, The Monthly Repository 1806-1838 (University of Carolina Press 1944):

"The first step taken to detach the Unitarian label from the Repository was the elimination of denominational intelligence. After January 1832, the magazine no longer published obituaries, news of Unitarian activities, or correspondence solely of interest to the denomination." (page 248).

The year 1832 saw the Repository's transition into a secular magazine and its light to shine under different editors until its demise in 1838. This last period 1832-38 has been much studied by scholars because of the many leading literary figures who wrote for it. But it was the Unitarian readership which kept it going, and when most of this disappeared after 1833, its economic fate was sealed as it was not possible to attract an equally loyal audience.

This present work is concerned with the obituaries which appeared in what can be called "the Unitarian period" of the magazine's life. 1485 obituaries appear between the first issue and February 1832. They represent a unique record of the life and personalities of Nonconformity, and particularly Unitarianism, reflecting back to the 18th century, and details of some of the obscure lives recorded there cannot be found in other sources. While it has proved possible to include only basic factual information on each person, the abridgement should be of interest to historians of Nonconformity, local studies enthusiasts, but perhaps most of all to genealogists and family historians.

Having an active interest in each of these branches prompted me to undertake the laborious task of extracting and recording the obituaries. I have noted only the bare facts but many of the obituaries are long and detailed, giving family as well as religious profile. For example, the family background and maiden name of married women is often given. Nonconformists seemed to specialise in these detailed obituaries which are not to be found in other publications until the 1850's. Some are finely written.

How did Aspland, setting out as a very inexperienced editor, obtain the obituaries? He obviously used denominational and a wide variety of other sources. Keith Williams has tellingly described what must have been Aspland's approach, so often used by other editors of the time:

"Papers were edited by guess and by Gutenberg. From haphazardly gathered selections of London and major foreign papers, spontaneous gleanings of items were reprinted with scant regard for authenticity. Sometimes these were amplified by privately written (and unpaid) letters submitted by correspondents." (The English Newspaper, an illustrated history 1977, page 65)

Aspland was in no position to pay for his material so he printed what he could dig out of newspapers and persuade out of people, particularly members of his Hackney congregation. His list of obituaries includes many famous people of the day, peers and large numbers of bishops and deans, few with any obvious Nonconformist connection. Many of the notices are straight lifts from The Times, Morning Post, etc. Some of the material included was grossly laudatory. Other obituaries thumped the denominational drum. As Aspland was perhaps the leading Unitarian propagandist of his day, he wished to prove the worth of the beliefs of the movement and defend them from attack. One of the main planks of that attack was that Unitarians "did not die well", they had no hope of the resurrection and often abandoned their faith on their deathbed. Aspland set out to include as many obituaries as possible to prove this accusation to be false. Thus there are many accounts of the painful death and last words of worthy people, affirming to the end belief in 'Unitarian principles'. The more humble and poor the person whose example could be quoted the better. Aspland's ideal of an 'improving' obituary was of a poor woman of high moral tone, who had left orthodoxy, discovered Unitarianism and declared at her death that it was a great prop. W.J. Fox kept up this policy while he still retained the Unitarian label, although in a muted manner, as it was clear that the rather partisan readership had grown to like it.

Towards the end of 1830, however, the regular laudation of dead but often obscure Unitarians was becoming too much for him and he wrote (November, page 800)

"We are not critical as to Obituaries; but we demur to the 'much admired peroration'. Our columns sufficiently shown what we deem admissable."

Clearly such obituaries were not to his taste and his ending of them early in 1832 should have come as no surprise to the readers.

Some interesting statistical analyses come out of the obituaries. It is not difficult, for example, to add up the number of men and women included. Of the 1485 obituaries, 1074 are male (73% of the total) and 411 female (27%) which is a higher proportion than might be expected. The reasons for this are unclear, but comparative figures for magazines catering in the main for other Nonconformist denominations are interesting. For the period 1793-1821, the Evangelical Magazine, from its indexes, shows there were 1314 obituaries consisting of 781 men (including 302 ministers) and 533 women; the Congregational Magazine for the period 1818-1832, 416 obituaries consisting of 383 men (including 289 ministers) and 33 women; and for ten random years of the Baptist magazine during the period 1809-1834, 284 obituaries consisting of 185 men (including 94 ministers) and 99 women. The number of ministers listed in the Monthly Repository is less easy to calculate for various reasons.

The amount of transcribing that has been done means that errors must have crept in despite the many checks that have been made. For these, I must make the usual apology. The indexes in the Repository are often incorrect, eg 1809, and I have extracted several that the original indexer missed, and possibly I may have counted the same person twice. Aspland occasionally inserted two obituaries for the same person at different times forgetting the earlier inclusion, e.g. Zimmerman. Details for the obituaries of leading figures are not always complete. Because these can be supplied from reference works such as the Dictionary of Natural Biography, the extract is shown as it was found on the printed page.

Obviously there is no substitute for the original text and all the information which can be found there. It is not possible to provide an exhaustive list of the places where the Repository for the period 1806-32 can be consulted, but the following libraries are known to have a full set: The British Library, the Bodlean Oxford, Manchester College Oxford, Unitarian College Manchester, Dr. William's Library and the Andover Harvard Theological Library (USA).

Explanatory Notes

The obituaries are listed in the order in which they appear; the page reference for the first and last obituary of each year is given. Each surname is identified by one forename initial only. However where no forenames are listed, just a title in the printed obituary, e.g. "Mr. Lane", the surname only is shown.
