Description of congregation(s)	A committed and supportive congregation, active in both church and LDPA events and community initiatives and with a well-supported programme of contributions to local charities.
Who we are, history etc.	The building dates from 1721 and is respected as one of Horsham’s most historic buildings. The congregation is principally drawn from the immediate Horsham area. As indicated by its name, the church has taken the initiative of converting to Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) status.
Current Service Pattern and resources available	The church itself is used only for Unitarian purposes. It has a fine organ, a computer-based projector and screen, a hearing loop system and multi-input audio system, plus computer and printer. The attached church hall is widely used by local groups and non-religious organisations. Lettings are according to a flexible scale of charges and form a valuable supplement to the church’s income.
Basis of Ministry	Half time
What the congregation seeks	First priority is the Sunday services, supplemented by weddings and other rights-of-passage events. We would also look to the minister to represent the church at the Unitarian Annual congress and local Unitarian events LDPA/ FUSE/ etc.
