



Unitarian Youth Programme Bursary Policy

What is the Youth Programme Bursary Policy?

The Unitarian Youth Programme offers support to those experiencing financial hardship to attend its youth programme events through the Unitarian Youth Programme Bursary Scheme.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Those experiencing financial hardship, which despite making savings and economies, would be unable to attend Youth Programme events.
- Participants aged between 7 and 17 are eligible to apply.
- Chaperones attending Junior Weekends are also eligible to apply.

Conditions Criteria:

- Financial assistance is only given to those applicants seeking to attend The Unitarian Youth Programme events. Other Unitarian or external events will not be considered.
- Applicants are eligible to apply for a maximum of 2 bursaries per calendar year. Bursary one may cover up to 100% of the total cost of the event. Bursary two may cover up to 50% of the total cost of the event.
- Applicants must complete the Unitarian Youth Programme Bursary Application Form.

Application Process

- Complete the Unitarian Youth Programme Bursary Application Form and return it to the Youth Programme by email at youth@unitarian.org.uk or by post to Unitarian Headquarters, Essex Hall, 1 Essex St, LONDON, WC2R 3HY.
- Applications must be made 7 days in advance of the event booking deadline. Applications made after the deadline will not be considered.
- Applicants must complete the bursary application form in full and return it 7 days in advance of the booking deadline. Incomplete or late forms will not be considered.
- The Youth Officer will notify the applicant within 3 days if their application has been successful.

Additional Support

- Applicants requiring additional financial support are encouraged to contact their local Unitarian congregation or district association.
- Applicants can also apply to receive financial support with travel costs to and from Youth Programme events. Contact the Youth Officer for more details.
